### 50. "Karina Aguilera Skvirsky: The Perilous Journey of María Rosa Palacios" at Smack Mellon

In 2015, Karina Aguilera Skvirsky documented her journey across Ecuador, traveling by mule, by riverboat, and by foot. It was a recreation of the path taken in 1906 by the artist's great-grandmother, then just 14 years old, shortly before the completion of a railroad route connecting the highlands and the coast. The resulting film is part documentary, part fiction, touching on a family history with wider resonance through timely issues of global identity.
